2 LX Sim Maps

LXSim comes with a preloaded map of ALPS (some parts) to keep a LXSIM application reasonably small. Missing maps can be installed additionally.

2.1 Installation via SeeYou

Maps consists from 2 files:

- Earth.cit
- Elev.cit

2.1.1 EARTH.cit

- Run SeeYou and then File->Mobile Wizard
- Tick only Terrain (select high details) and Roads, Rails, Lakes and Towns. Leave everything else unticked.
- Press Next and enter under Files basename "earth".
- Under destination select Copy to My Computer and press Browse button.
- Search for folder where you LXSim is installed. Usually it will be c:\Program Files\LXNAV\LXSim.
- Select data subfolder c:\Program Files\LXNAV\LXSim\data\ (In this folder there should already be a file earth.cit)
- Press Next again
- Select region you would like to see
- Press Next again.

2.1.2 ELEV.cit

- Run Mobile Wizard again
- Tick only Terrain elevations. Leave everything else unticked.
- Press Next and enter under Files basename "elev".
- Repeat steps 4 to 9.
